## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

We've had number of wonderful discoveries and opportunities for our documentary series in 2023. First, we decided to change the working title to **Breathless**. This dramatic and mysterious title draws us into a story about an elusive and complex disorder that is insidious and very dangerous. This name change came when we pushed up editing on an updated trailer, a sizzle reel, while the Foundation was exploring new relationships. These connections would provide more comprehensive filming opportunities that would extend into early next year. The video, a sizzle reel, pointed to this broader direction and required an eye-catching title.

The sizzle reel had us start postproduction earlier than originally planned as we began to review and organize all the material for the editing phase. Breaking down hundreds of hours of documentary material filmed over seven years and preparing it for remote editors takes weeks and is a must for a smooth edit process. During this time, we discovered that the patient-physician stories we had filmed were more powerful and moving than we originally thought. The sizzle shows the impact of this emotion.

We are now filming people of all ages and backgrounds who have had different journeys than our main subject, Sydney Avis, and presenting real world examples of common symptoms, diagnoses, and treatments that viewers are familiar with and can easily relate to. We also cover diverse treatments like CPAP | BIPAP, nerve stimulation and other devices and procedures. We continue to focus on patients who have experienced profound physical, mental, and emotional transformations.

We have also highlighted the importance of early intervention. This year, we filmed children whose lives will be forever altered after proper diagnosis and treatment. Our cameras have explored new technology and will capture physicians who have improved sleep disorder testing and use surgical procedures that have made correcting airway challenges more accessible and affordable.

Our edit road map has us intercutting all of these stories with Sydney's experience. Her journey shows how years of suffering could have been avoided if the very things we are learning in this documentary series were available to her when she was young. This approach, weaving the stories into a three part docuseries, is the recipe for success. We will create a perfect mix of emotion and information.

These narratives will be supported by looking at the anatomical evolution of the face and how it has impaired function. The audience will be surprised by what is not necessarily taught in medical schools. And they will appreciate going behind the scenes and getting the scoop on proper diagnosis and treatment. This docuseries is different than others. It is not really about other people or about the professionals. It's about you, someone you love, or perhaps your child.

We will finish up filming and enter full post production in 2024. We expect to begin the distribution process by second quarter. We believe this docuseries will capture the hearts of millions around the world and, of course, the network execs who will greenlight distribution.

In an inspiring and impactful evening on November 20th, The Airway Revolution Foundation marked a significant milestone with its first Community Health Literacy Program. Held at the Staten Island JCC, the event not only brought awareness about airway disorders, but also fostered community engagement and education.

The program kicked off with a heartfelt address by the foundation's Executive Director, Sydney Avis, who shared her personal journey with an airway disorder. The program Included an exclusive preview of the extended trailer for the documentary series crafted by our 17-time award-winning film team. Emotive and entertaining, the preview offered an insight into the depth, breath and diversity of the docuseries as well as a glimpse into several lives affected by airway disorders.

Dr. Victor Avis, in his presentation, skillfully wove together the perspectives of the preceding experts. Confirming the critical collaboration of the multiple specialties, he spoke passionately about the profound impact treating airway disorders can have on the quality of life for both children and adults. Exhorting the importance of early intervention, Dr. Avis also emphasized the opportunities for prevention. Following the film, the audience heard from four distinguished airway experts who delved into various aspects of child development and the impact of airway disorders.

Dr. Amy Racanello, a neuropyschologist, illuminated the significance of the first 1,000 days in a child's life, emphasizing the critical role this period plays in overall development.

Next, Lisa Paladino, IBCLC, brought attention to the importance of breastfeeding and its correlation with early childhood growth and development.

Dr. Michele DeSimone, a speechlanguage pathologist, shared valuable insights into the signs of airway disorders and explained the significance of the oral and facial muscles in the development of the airway.

The program concluded with a dynamic question and answer session. Displaying enthusiasm, engagement, curiosity, and emotion, the audience expressed disbelief at how these disorders have been overlooked for so long. The relevance of the program and the encouragement for more similar programs was communicated through both real time feedback and surveys.

Looking ahead, The Airway Revolution Foundation is excited to announce its next community program scheduled for early 2024. The foundation is also actively in talks with various community leaders, including Wagner College, to host and cohost programs in additional locations. The overwhelmingly positive feedback from the inaugural program serves as a testament to the need for public awareness and education concerning airway disorders, and the importance for the foundation to meet this need through our community health literacy programs.
